Hall Street and Maude Street, Cheltenham – Temporary change to parking conditions

Background

Council is responding to concerns from the community about the number of construction staff from the Level Crossing Removal Project parking in Hall Street and Maude Street in Cheltenham during the main occupation which is currently underway. Currently there is '4P 8am-5pm Mon-Fri' parking restrictions in place on both sides of these roads.

Council Action

To help manage this issue and provide greater parking opportunities for residents during this time, Council is proposing to change the current 4P parking restrictions to 1 1/2P (90min) on one side of the road in these streets (see over page for more detail). Additionally, this 90min restriction will be in place Monday-Sunday.

This change has been fast-tracked due to community feedback and will occur on Monday 1 June.

Please note: this will be a temporary change and will only be in place for the duration of the main occupation. The original restrictions will be returned in the week starting 27 July 2020, subject to contractor availability.
