Jolimont Place, Dingley Village – Parking Changes

Background

In February 2020, Council consulted with local residents about a proposed parking change in Jolimont Place, Dingley Village. The change was in response to community concerns regarding parking and access issues.

During this consultation Council sought feedback on a proposed new parking layout, with alternating parking spaces provided on both sides of the street between the traffic island and the eastern end of the road. The proposal resulted in a total of 16 parking spaces, 7 on the south side and 9 on the north side of the street.

Council Action

Council appreciates the feedback received and has made some changes to the design in response to what we heard.

The revised parking design will still provide a total of 16 parking spaces, however 8 will be on the south side and 8 on the north side of the street. A diagram with more detail can be found overleaf.

The parking changes will be marked out with a water-based paint and Council will continue to monitor parking in the street.

The work will be completed in the next 4-6 weeks.
