## Bourke Road, Clarinda – Proposed speed humps

### Background

In August, Council wrote to residents regarding the feedback received on proposed traffic calming measures on Bourke Road. The feedback showed strong support from residents for the measures shown in the attached plan. The plan shows four speed humps, including a hump adjacent to 144 Bourke Road and Clarinda Retirement Village. During the detailed design, Council identified drainage issues associated with providing a hump adjacent to number 144.

### Council Action

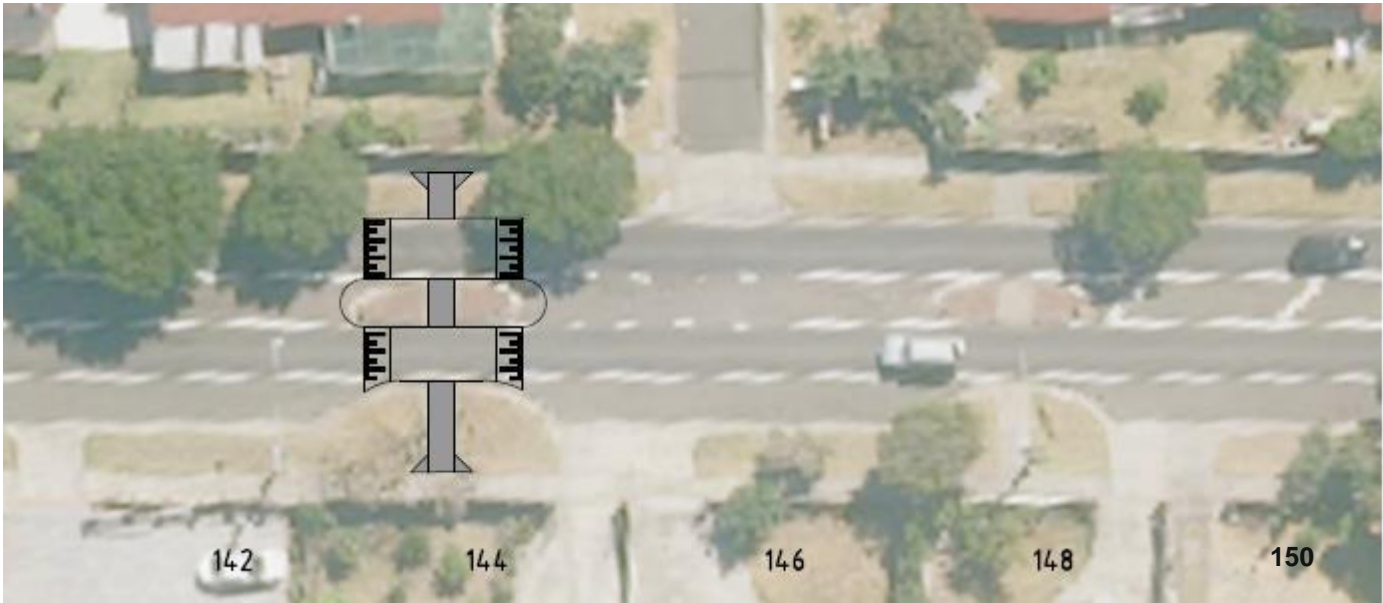
Consequently, Council is proposing to relocate the hump (with new kerb-buildouts and a pedestrian refuge island) approximately 40m to the east - opposite 150 Bourke Road (see attached plan). The existing kerb outstand and centre island at number 148 Bourke Road will also be removed. Relocating the proposed hump to this new location will remove the need for extensive drainage works.

Council will continue the detailed design stage, with construction expected to take place in the 2020/21 financial year. Residents will be notified closer to the construction period.
