Main Street, Mordialloc – Proposed Disabled Parking Bay

Background

In response to community concerns regarding a lack of disabled parking opportunities in Main Street, Mordialloc, Council is proposing to install an additional disabled parking bay.

Council Action

Council seeks your opinion on the following changes to parking conditions in Station Road (see image on following page):

- Convert the first parallel 2P 9am-6pm parking bay, opposite 554 Main Street, to one 2P full-sized disabled parking bay.

The installation of the disabled parking bay will provide the opportunity for disabled permit holders better access to the Main Street shops. A ramp will be installed along the kerb to allow access from the disabled parking bay to the footpath.

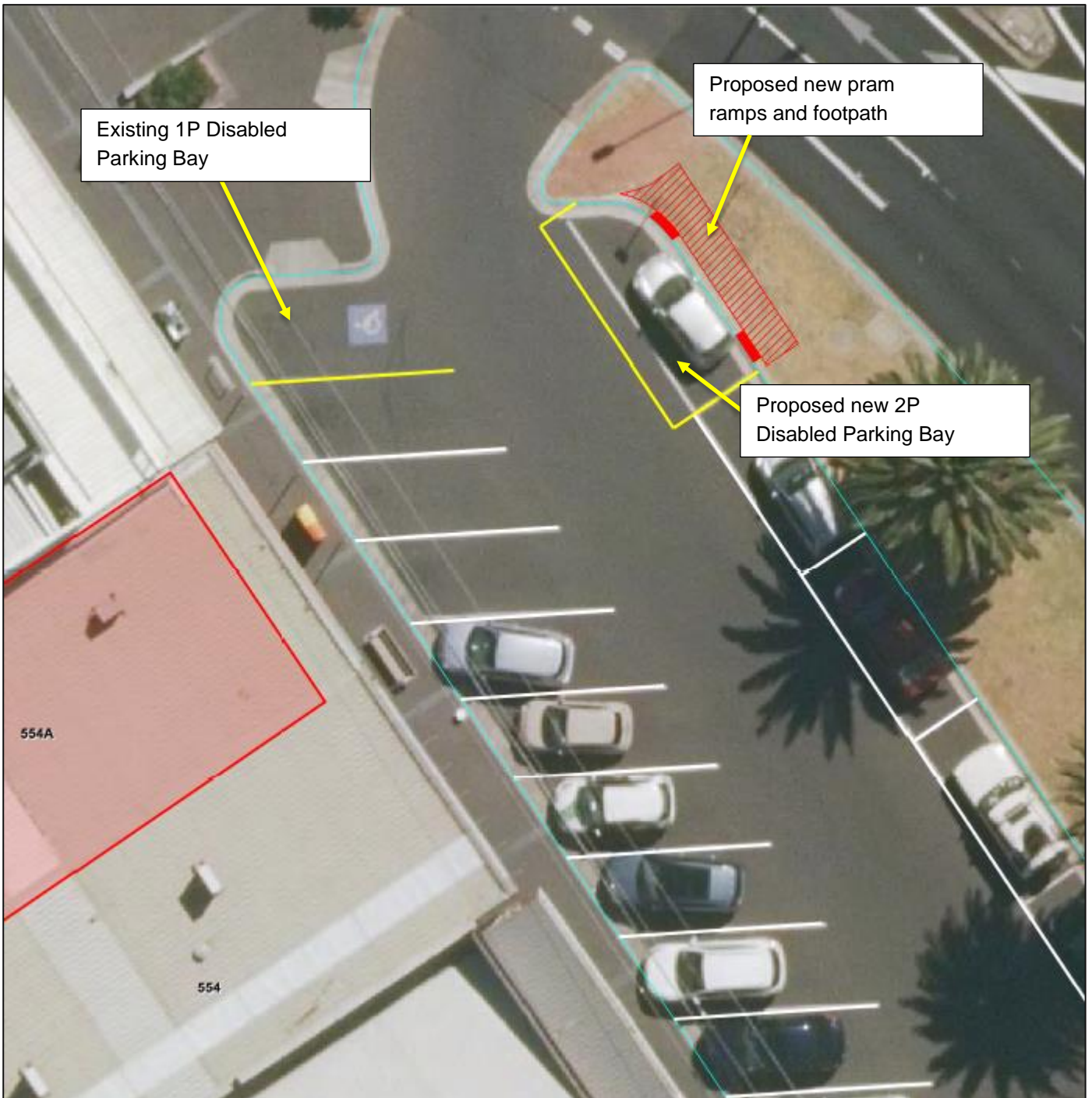
