Nepean Highway, Parkdale – Proposed Parking Change and Speed Cushions

Background

Council is responding to community concerns about parking and traffic in the Nepean Highway service road between Fourth Street and Sixth Street, Parkdale following a report to Council in August 2019.

Council Action

An investigation has been undertaken including an assessment of the service road and parking. The results show that some sections of the service road are too narrow to allow parking, as a minimum 3m width is required under the Road Rules.

Council proposes the following measures to manage the parking and traffic: (please refer to the plan overleaf for more details)

1. Install 'no stopping' signs along the Nepean Highway service road between Fourth and Sixth Streets where parking should not be permitted due to the narrow width of the road.

The results of the assessment also showed that the intersection of Fifth Street and Nepean Highway has an old intersection layout which is not consistent with the current design guidelines from the Department of Transport. As such, Council will consider funding the modification of the intersection to current standards through the budget deliberations for the 2020/2021 financial year.

As an interim safety improve, Council proposes the following measures for Fifth Street and Nepean Highway intersection: (please refer to the plan overleaf for more details)

2. Install a pair of speed cushions near the intersection of Fifth Street and Nepean Highway to the north to slow vehicle travelling speed on entry to the service road.



