Florence Lane, Mentone – Proposed Parking Changes

Background

Council is responding to community concerns about the parking in Florence Lane, Mentone.

Council Action

An investigation has been undertaken including an assessment of Florence Lane, its usage and the current parking controls.

The results showed that Florence Lane is a registered Council Road and should be kept clear to provide access to local businesses. However, Council acknowledges the demand for some short-term parking in the laneway to enable local businesses to conduct loading and unloading.

Currently, there are 'No Stopping' signs and a yellow edge line located in the laneway that restricts vehicles from parking in the laneway. To balance access and loading requirements, Council will install 'No Parking' signs towards the northern end of the laneway, where access is less critical. Please refer to the plan overleaf for more details.

In accordance with the Victorian Road Rules, a 'No Parking' sign allows vehicles to make temporary stops to drop-off and pick-up passengers or goods for up to 2 minutes, provided that drivers are within 3 metres of the vehicle. The new signs will be erected in the next 4-6 weeks.
