Malcolm Road Drainage Improvements, Braeside

Council is continuing to invest significantly in Kingston's roads, footpath and drainage network to support the current and future needs of our community.

Due to minor localised flooding in Malcolm Road Council is planning to undertake some stormwater drainage improvements. The works involve reconstruction of drainage pits and sections of kerb in front of 33-35 and 50-56 Malcolm Road as indicated in the attached map and will help to alleviate the flooding.

Construction Details

Works are expected to begin in early 2022 and will take around 2 weeks to complete.

To ensure safety during the works the footpath will be closed to the public whilst the construction is taking place. Alternative routes will be provided, and Council will work with the community to minimise the disruption.

We apologise for any inconvenience during the works and look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.

Closer to the time of construction an additional bulletin will be provided, with detailed information on who to contact if any issues arise during construction.
