Henry Street, Heatherton – Proposed Speed Humps

Background

Council is responding to community concerns regarding hooning and burn-out activity along Henry Street in Heatherton. Council has investigated these concerns and it has been determined that the implementation of traffic calming measures in Henry Street is warranted.

Council Action

The best solution to this issue would be to formally seal Henry Street, however the timing of this would be subject to Council's budget process. As an interim measure, Council is proposing a trial to install four speed humps to determine their effectiveness. Based on the results of this trial, Council will decide on more permanent solutions in the future.

These four speed humps will be placed along the length of Henry Street and at the ends of Nicholas Grove and Golf View Road. Please see the attached plan for more information. The speed humps will help to manage hooning behaviour, which will reduce risks and improve safety.

The work will be implemented in the next 4-6 weeks.
