Chapel Road, Moorabbin – Bus Access and Loading Zone

Background

Council is responding to community concerns regarding lack of bus access in Chapel Road near the South Road intersection. Furthermore, Council has received trader requests to install a loading zone within the area for the shops at 472-486 South Road. Council is proposing to change the current parking conditions in Chapel Road to improve bus access and the delivery of goods to nearby traders.

Council Action

Council seeks your opinion for the following changes to Chapel Road (see image over page):

Option 1 – Remove existing 15-minute restrictions and replace with a loading zone.

Option 2 – Retain existing 15-minute restrictions.

Additionally, Council will be installing an additional 'No Stopping' zone north of South Lane on the east side of Chapel Road, shown in the diagram overleaf. The installation of this 'No Stopping' zone will give buses sufficient space and prevent delay.

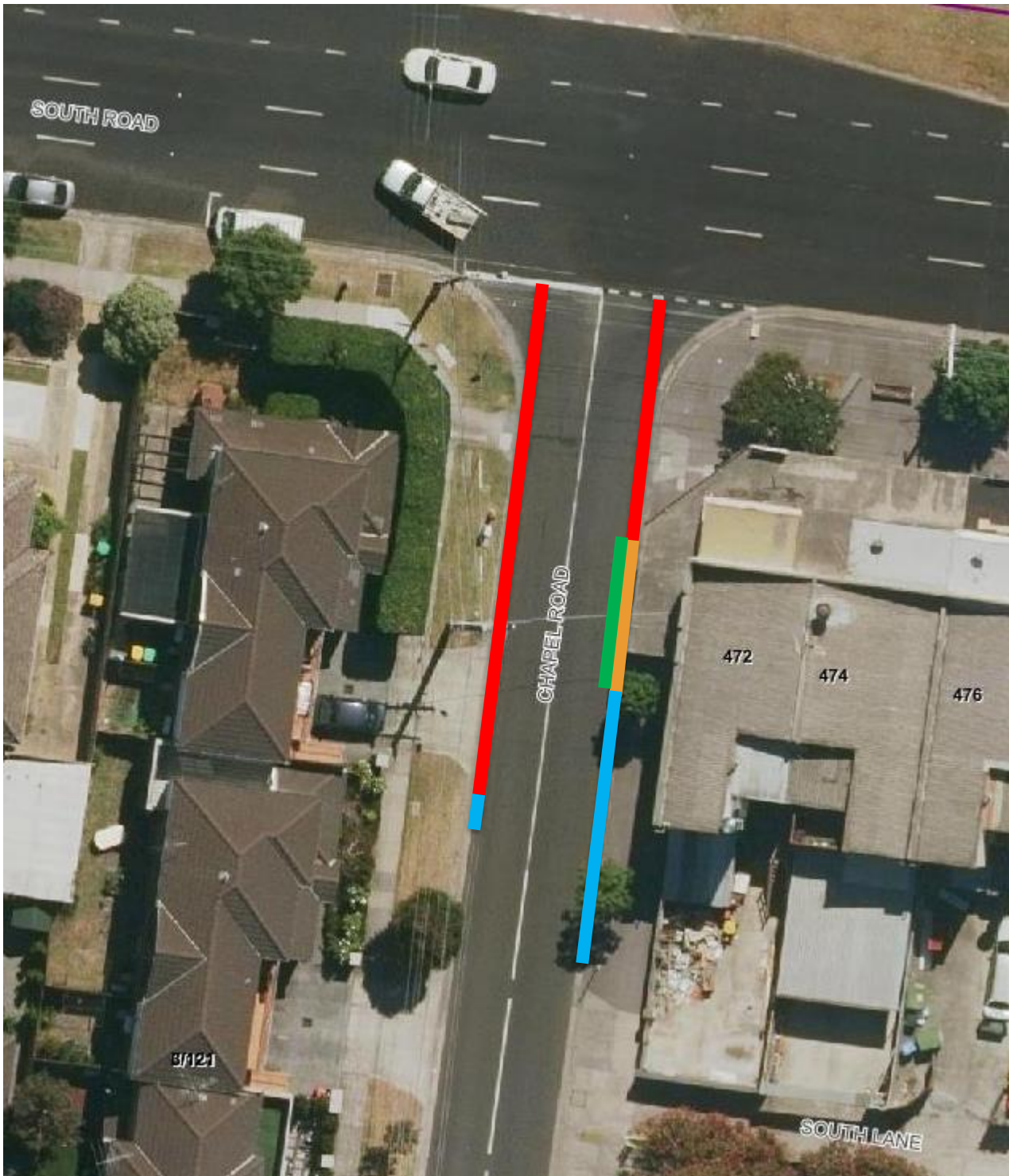
