## Cheltenham area south of the activity centre – Proposed change to parking conditions

### Background

The Level Crossing Removal Project (LXRP) has recently closed the car park at Cheltenham station. As a result, there is limited all-day parking for commuters in the vicinity.

At a recent Council meeting, Councillors requested that Council officers “urgently consult with residents about removing the four-hour parking restrictions from one side of the roads south of Cheltenham Activity Centre that currently have restrictions on both sides of the road in order to provide more all-day parking.”

Council is now seeking residents’ feedback on temporary changes to the current parking conditions in several streets in Cheltenham that will provide a better overall balance of parking in the area during the LXRP works.

### Council Action

Council has conducted a review of the area and seeks your opinion on the following temporary parking changes (see image over page):

- Removal of the ‘4P 8am-5pm Mon-Fri’ parking restrictions and conversion to unrestricted parking on the north side of the following streets:
  - Cameron Street
  - Page Street
  - Tuck Street
  - Hoffman Street (between Edward Street and Elman Street)
- Removal of the ‘4P 8am-5pm Mon-Fri’ parking restrictions and conversion to unrestricted parking on the west side of the following streets:
  - Courtney Street
  - Hoffman Street (between Cameron Street and Tuck Street)
  - Nepean Highway Service Road

Please note: if approved, one side of the street will retain short term parking restrictions to ensure adequate parking opportunities for residents and their visitors. Parking conditions will be reviewed following the LXRP works.


