Woods Ave/Chute St Intersection, Mordialloc – Drainage Improvement

Council is continuing to invest significantly in Kingston's roads, footpath and drainage network to support the current and future needs of our community.

To reduce the impact of temporary flooding at the intersection during periods of heavy rainfall, and to improve the safety and amenity for pedestrians and residents, Council is planning to install a new grate pit and 375mm diameter drainage pipe across Woods Avenue near the Woods Avenue and Chute Street intersection in Mordialloc. In addition, the pram crossing, kerb return and road pavement outside 1/74 Chute Street will also be reconstructed. Please refer to enclosed plan for further details.

Construction Details

Works are expected to commence early in 2022 and will take around 2 weeks to complete.

The construction works will restrict access to some pedestrian areas for short periods. Council will endeavour to minimise disruption and will provide adequate signage for alternative pathways.

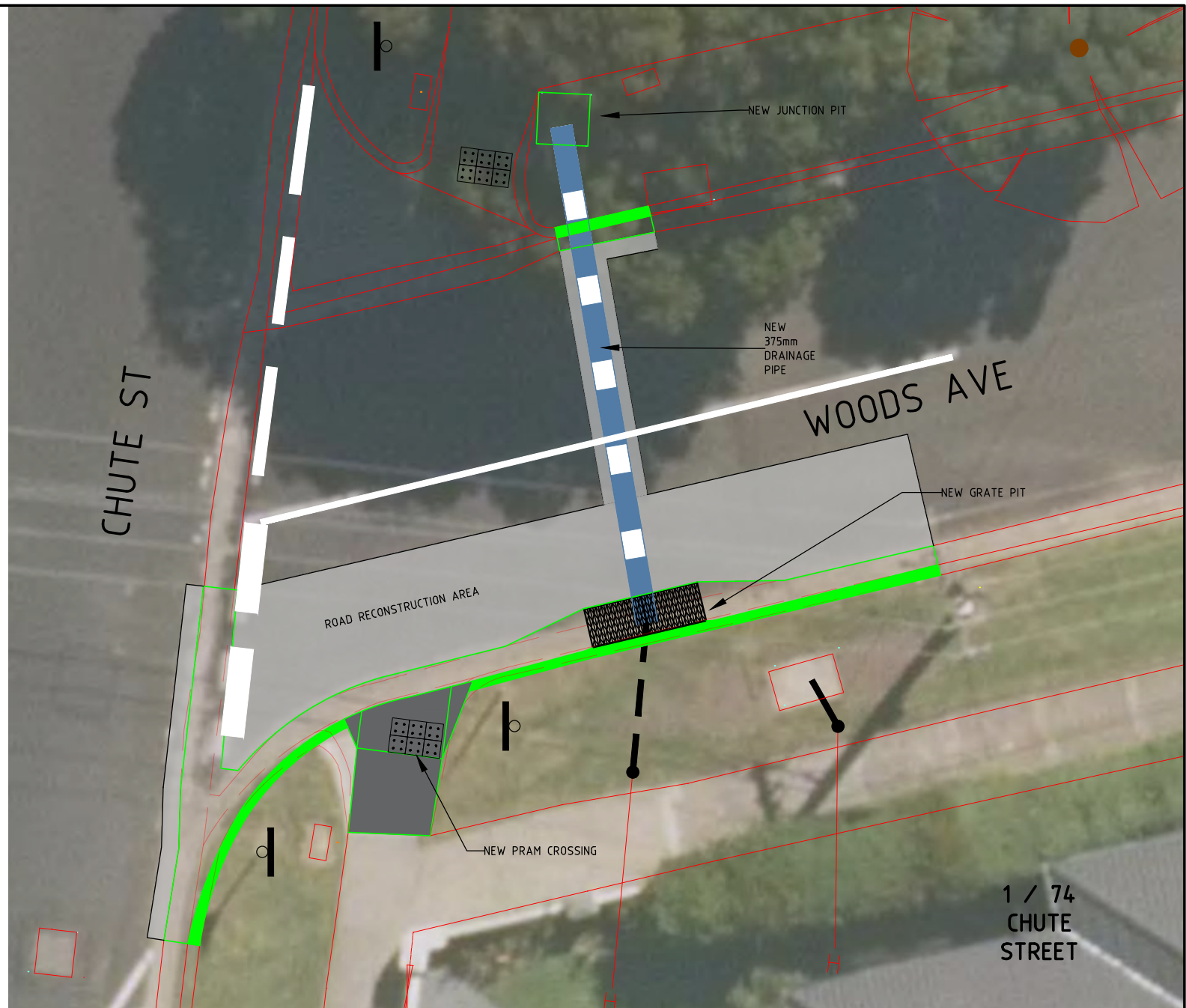
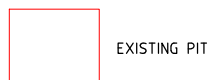
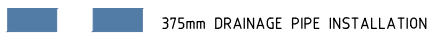
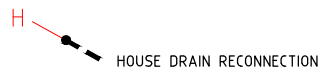
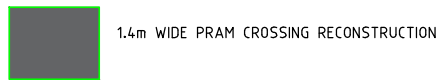
Closer to the time of construction an additional bulletin will be provided, with detailed information on who to contact if any issues arise during construction.
