Turakina Avenue, Edithvale – Proposed Parking Restrictions

Background

Council is responding to community concerns regarding vehicle access in Turakina Avenue (outside 6 Bank Road) due to vehicles parking on both sides of the road. An investigation confirmed that the road width varies between 6.8 - 7 metres, which creates access issues for larger vehicles (including emergency vehicles). This justifies the removal of the three on-street parking spaces outside 6 Bank Road (Turakina Avenue side). Therefore, Council is proposing to change parking conditions in Turakina Avenue to improve vehicle access within the street.
