Congratulations! This letter is to confirm your registration for Kingston Arts' **Artz Blitz 2020** competition. Just a few reminders before the big event!

Creative Writing format (Updated in 2020)

- All creative writers will respond to the theme at the same time as visual artists; writing an original fiction or non-fiction piece in any style or genre.
- **Adult 18+ entrant word-length: 300-500 words**
- **Youth (13-17yrs) and Junior (12 and under) entrant word-length: 100 – 300 words.**
- All creative writing pieces should be submitted digitally as a word document via email.
- Hardcopies will only be accepted in-person during artwork drop-offs on Saturday 14 March between 3-5pm at Kingston City Hall.

1. Your Title Card that you will need to fill out and emailed to visualarts@kingston.vic.gov.au or deliver in person on Saturday 14th March 3pm – 5pm.

Please note that no works within the writing category will be for sale.

2. A map of the Kingston City Hall and Arts Centre on the Nepean Hwy.
3. Photographic permission forms for children 17 and under, which must be completed and emailed to a staff member

How to submit

- Please submit as a **digital word doc file** and email to visualarts@kingston.vic.gov.au on Saturday 14th March **any time before 5pm**. Alternatively, you may submit as a **hardcopy between 3 – 5pm only (formatted)**
- Please submit photographic permission forms for children 17 and under (if applicable) via email with your creative writing entry.
- If you **do not consent** to your child being photographed during the opening event, please make yourself known to the photographer on the day.
- Late entries will **NOT** be accepted. Entries that do not meet the requirements will NOT be judged. No exceptions.

Award Presentation and Opening

- The Artz Blitz Opening will be from 4pm - 6pm on Sunday 15th March and entry is free!
- Award presentations will be held at 4pm in the City Hall Foyer, before moving to the Galleries in the Kingston Arts Centre next door.
- Complimentary refreshments, roving entertainment and free workshops by artist and jeweller, Emma Grace will be held at Kingston Arts Centre. Your friends and family are very welcome to attend with you.

- Parking available in the City Hall Carpark (no permits required), however spots are limited. Travel by public transport is recommended with Moorabbin Train Station and Bus Exchange are less than 200m from the venues.

Collecting works at the end of the exhibition

- **If you wish to collect your work after the exhibition, it must be collected after the long weekend between Tuesday 28th April (9am-5pm) and Saturday 2nd May (12-5pm).**
- Artists or their representatives must produce suitable identification (i.e. Driver's Licence) when collecting work/s
- Uncollected works cannot be stored at Kingston Arts Centre and will be disposed of.

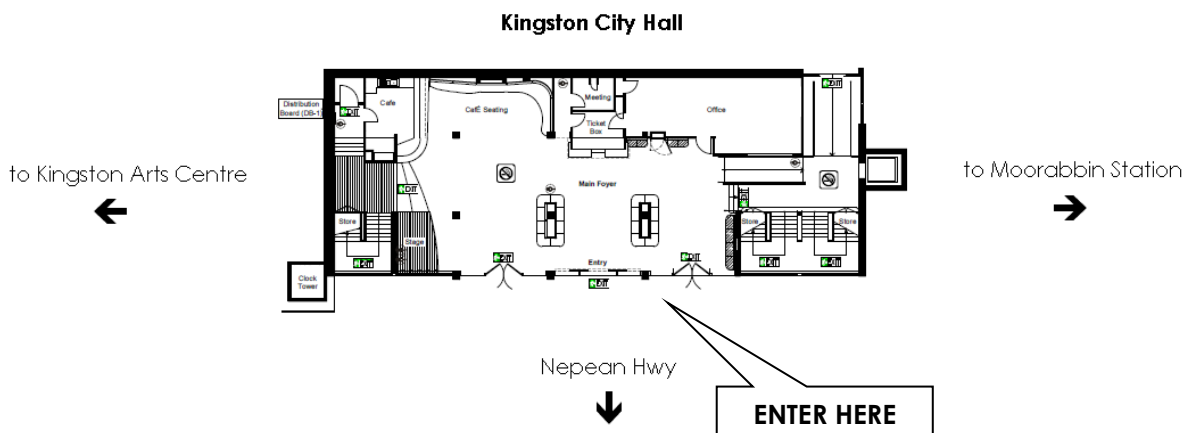
