

Bunjil Ward

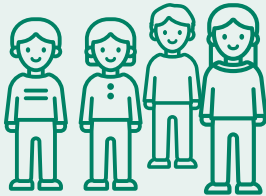
This ward is named in honour of Bunjil, the wedge-tailed eagle, the creator deity of the local indigenous people of Kingston, the Bunurong People of the Kulin Nation.

People

There were **17,825** people living in Bunjil in 2021, this makes up 11% of the Kingston population.

The population in Bunjil grew at a higher rate than Kingston from 2016 to 2021

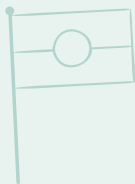
