Improving access to Parkdale Beach

We're working to improve access to Kingston's beaches. As part of this commitment, we're planning to upgrade beach access and parking at the Parkdale Yacht Club. The project has been split into 2 stages:

Stage 1 – Construction of an asphalt car park with accessible parking bay, kerb and channel, underground drainage and lighting.

These works will also include:

- · Rescue boat parking, and
- New PTV bus stop with improved safety.

Stage 2 – Construction of an accessible ramp to foreshore with seating and lighting.

Background

We are working to improve community access to the beach, building and shared user path. Building an accessible ramp to the beach is just one part of a much bigger plan to improve accessibility by installing DDA-compliant pedestrian ramps along Kingston's stunning foreshore.

Thanks to all all you who provided feedback through our community consultation last year. You helped to shape what's being delivered in this precinct.

Construction Details

Council has awarded a contract for stage 1 works. Construction is anticipated to start in August 2023 and will take 2–3 months to complete.

Stage 2 works will go out to tender in the coming months with construction to commence in autumn 2024 (just after the sailing season has finished).

During the first stage of construction, pedestrian access will not be permitted near the works for safety reasons. We will aim to minimise disruption and will provide adequate signage for alternative pathways.

We apologise for any inconvenience during the works and look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.
