Coast Banksia Woodland



Ecological Vegetation Classes (EVC) are the standard unit for classifying vegetation types in Victoria.

EVC:2 Coast Banksia Woodland | Kingston Status: Endangered

Restricted to near coastal localities on secondary or tertiary dunes behind Coastal Dune Scrub. Usually dominated by a woodland overstorey of Coast Banksia over a medium shrub layer. The understorey consists of a number of herbs and sedges, including scramblers.
