

Damp Sands Herb-rich Woodland

Ecological Vegetation Classes (EVC) are the standard unit for classifying vegetation types in Victoria.

EVC:3 Damp Sands Herb-rich Woodland | Kingston Status: Endangered

A low, grassy or bracken-dominated eucalypt forest or open woodland with a large shrub layer and ground layer rich in herbs, grasses, and orchids. Occurs mainly on flat or undulating areas on moderately fertile, relatively well-drained, deep sandy or loamy topsoils over heavier subsoils (duplex soils).
